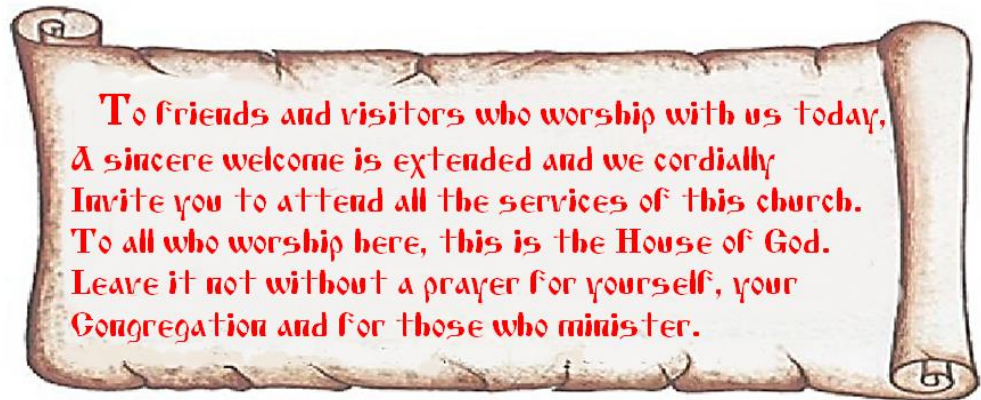

Because of the nature of my injuries and surgeries, I needed virtually constant attention, assistance with meal preparations, mobility and transport.

May God grant them and everybody in this community health, happiness and many years of blessings! You are certainly missed!
