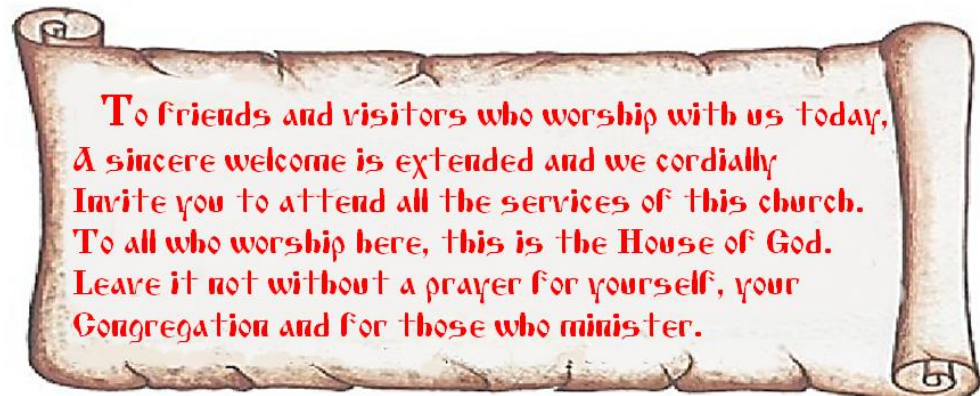

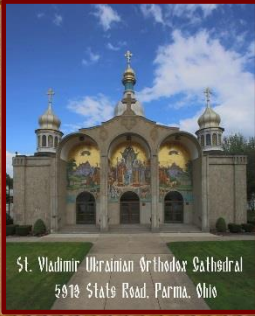

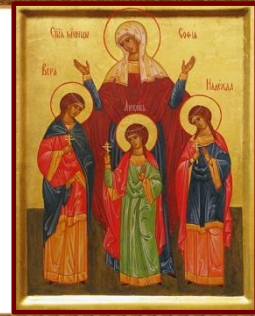

**UKRAINE'S  
FAMINE/GENOCIDE  
1932-33**

Survivors recount the horrors of living through the little known Ukrainian Famine/Genocide, engineered by Soviet dictator Joseph Stalin in 1932-33. Millions of people died, a third of them children, as brigades forcibly confiscated all livestock, grain and foodstuffs while the world turned a blind eye. Journalists were barred from Ukraine and borders were closed. Fearing for their lives, no one spoke of this atrocity until 1991 when Ukraine gained independence. But the consequences of this genocide continue to reverberate today as Ukraine struggles to become a true democracy.
