



Annunciation of the Mother of God – Благовіщення Пресвятої Богородиці

On April 7, our Holy Orthodox Church, according Julian Calendar celebrates the Annunciation by archangel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary that she should become the mother of Jesus Christ the Son of God. Today is exactly nine months before Christmas!

It is the day Archangel Gabriel announced the Incarnation of Christ, saying to the Birth Giver, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. (Luke 1:31)

This occurred, as some Church writers have related, precisely the same moment that she held open the book of the Prophet Isaiah and was contemplating his great prophecy: Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and bear a son! (Isaiah 7:14). Gabriel appeared in all of his angelic brightness and saluted her: Rejoice, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you! (Luke 1:28), and the rest, as it is written in the Gospel of the blessed Luke. With this angelic annunciation and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Virgin, the salvation of mankind and the restoration of all creation began. The history of the New Testament was opened by the words of the Archangel Gabriel: Rejoice, thou that art highly favored. This shows that the New Testament signified joy to mankind and to all created things. Therefore, the Annunciation is considered not only a great feast but also a joyful feast.
